The Bible has a lot to say about laziness:

Proverbs 19:15	azy peop	le are go	ing to I	be hungry.
----------------	----------	-----------	----------	------------

Proverbs 12:24 Laziness is contrasted with diligence. The diligent rule. The lazy will be

under the dominion of a governor.

Proverbs 18:9 The slothful man and the wasteful man are brothers.

Proverbs 21:25 The lazy person will covet what other people have but won't labor for it.

Proverbs 22:13 Lazy people have a lot of wild excuses for not being able to work.

Proverbs 26:14 If a lazy person moves at all, they still aren't going anywhere.

GOD IS NOT LAZY: If you are going to follow the Lord, you can't be lazy.

Eccl 10:18

If you have a house, it is going to require constant maintenance. If you're lazy, your house will fall apart.

- This principle applies also to your spiritual life, your family, your career, and your ministry.
- Evolution is the Devil's lie. Things don't improve over time, they decay.

Prov 24:30-34

The field of the slothful will cause people to wonder what happened to your property. All it takes is "a little sleep" and "a little slumber" and "a little folding of the hands to sleep" and you'll soon find yourself in poverty.

- Just as a little exercise will *eventually* improve your strength a lot, a "little" slothfulness will eventually result in a "lot" of loss.
- If you reduce your diligence to serve God just a little bit, it will
 eventually result in your standards of service decreasing to
 spiritual poverty levels.
- Raising children requires continual daily care if you want them to turn out to be proper adults. If you slack off a little, it will cause bigger problems later.

Romans 12:9-13 Christians are commanded not to be slothful in business.

 That includes God's business. You can't be a pastor, evangelist, or missionary if you are lazy.

Hebrews 6:11-12 Diligence is needed in the service of God. Don't wait until you see others make a move. You make a move to serve, and if anyone wants to follow you, they'll have to keep up.

Judges 18:9

The children of Israel never took possession of the entire Promised Land because they were slothful.

 Why are you still allowing sin to remain in your life? Are you too lazy? It's time to fight that thing and be done with it.

Ezekiel 16:48-49

Before the people of Sodom became involved in perverse sexual sins, there was something else that led to it: pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness.

 A nation with plenty of food and too much free time will soon become corrupt and depraved.

Prov 31:10, 27

The virtuous woman is not lazy. She's busy from sunrise to sunset.

1 Tim 5:11-13

The idle woman (someone who is not doing anything productive) will wander about telling tales, tattling, being a busybody, and speaking things they ought not.

If you're not doing something for the Lord because you don't think you're able, just start to do a little, and then work up to more and more until it becomes easier.
