1. LIVING WATER (John 4:9-10)

- We seek satisfaction through many vices, and we are never satisfied.
- Finally, through salvation by Jesus Christ, we are fully and completely satisfied. We shall never thirst (vs 13).
 - o In Christ, we have a reason for living. Only Jesus Christ can truly satisfy your soul.
 - Once we receive the living water, we immediately want others to have it also. We want to tell people about our wonderful Savior (vs 29).

2. HIS FLESH (John 6:48-51)

- Jesus Christ gave His flesh so that we might have life.
- Hebrews 10:10-13 tells us Jesus Christ offered His body "once for all." It was "one sacrifice for sins for ever."
- No man can offer his flesh to pay for his sins. No works or offerings will do the job.
- Genesis 22:8 "God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering." (with 1 Tim 3:16).
- John 1:29 "Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world."

3. HIS LIFE (John 10:11)

• "I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep."

4. ETERNAL LIFE (Ephesians 2:8-9, John 10:27-28)

- Those who receive Christ shall never perish. You cannot lose your salvation.
- The doctrine of eternal life doesn't make a person feel free to sin. It makes that person thankful to Jesus Christ. It makes you want to live for Him.

5. HIS EXAMPLE (John 13:12-16)

- Jesus showed us that no task is too menial.
- Rebellion against God brings unhappiness and dissatisfaction to your life.
- Serving others is a joy when we humble ourselves and follow Jesus' example (Heb 12:2, Ps 40:8).
- The examples in this world will always let you down, turn on you, and lead you astray.

6. THE COMFORTER (John 14:15-17)

- The Holy Spirit cannot be seen; therefore, the world cannot receive Him (vs 17).
 - o This passage proves that tongues is not the "initial evidence of the Holy Spirit."
 - If you want to see something, you won't receive the Holy Spirit.
 - If you see something, it is not the Holy Spirit.
 - Baptism can be seen, therefore it is not the means of salvation.
 - You've got to receive God's gift by faith (not sight) before the Holy Spirit, the Comforter comes to indwell you.
- The Holy Spirit will Comfort you in this cold, callous world.
 - o **Job 5:6-8** You are going to have trouble in this world.
 - Through it all, you have God's Comforter.

7. HIS PEACE (John 14:27)

- Not just peace, but His peace. Jesus is not worried or afraid about anything. He gives us that same peace.
- Lay your troubles and concerns at the feet of Jesus and trust that you are safe in his hands.

8. HIS WORD (John 17:8, 14)

- Matthew 24:35 "35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away."
- The word of God is incorruptible (1 Pet 1:23).
- His word is truth (John 17:17).

9. HIS GLORY (John 17:20-22)

- This glory is reserved for "them also which shall believe on me through their word."
 - Whatever this glory entails, it gave Jesus Christ the grace to lay down His life for others and then be raised from the dead by God.
 - o It is the same glory Jesus had in heaven with the Father (vs 5).
