## **Chapter 19 Preparation: The Conversion of the Nation of Israel**

Romans 11:21-28	All Israel shall be saved.
Jeremiah 50:4-8	Israel will seek the Lord and enter into an everlasting covenant. A nation shall be born at once (rebirth of the nation of Israel).
Daniel 9:24	Daniel's Seventieth Week will end with the end of sin and iniquity with the nation of Israel entering into a right relationship with God.
Ezekiel 36:25-29	Israel will be cleansed, given a new heart of flesh, receive God's Spirit, and obey God's commandments in the land that He promised their fathers.
Jeremiah 50:20	God will pardon the nation of Israel. Their iniquity shall not be found.
Jeremiah 33:7-8	God will cleanse Judah and Israel from all their iniquity, whereby they have sinned against God.
Isaiah 45:25	God will justify the nation of Israel.
Isaiah 44:21-22	God will blot out the transgressions of Israel and redeem them.
Acts 3:12-13, 19-20	Peter preached of the blotting out of Israel's sin at the Second Coming of Christ.
Zechariah 3:1-10	The Lord will rebuke Satan, pluck Israel out of the fire, take away her filthy garments, remove her iniquity, clothe her and crown her. God will do it in one day.
	<ul> <li>Jesus made it possible for God to pardon their iniquity when He asked Him to forgive them, "for they know not what they do." (Luke 23:34).</li> <li>That changed the crime of murder (Lev 24:17) into manslaughter (Numbers 35:12).</li> </ul>
Hebrews 8:7-11	God will make a new covenant with the nation of Israel wherein He will place His laws into their mind and write them in their hearts.
Numbers 23:19-21	Balaam prophesied concerning the nation of Israel. He saw a time when God did not see iniquity in Jacob.
Ezekiel 37:1-14	The Prophet Ezekiel saw a future time when God would raise up an army from the whole house of Israel to fight their oppressors at Armageddon.
