

REVELATION Lesson 170

Chapter 19:14, The Lord's Coming with His Armies

Jude 14-15 Enoch was the first man to prophesy in the bible. He prophesied of the Lord's Second Coming with His saints to execute judgment upon all the ungodly.

- The Lord will convince the world (with a sword) that He is a God who executes judgment upon all sinners.
- Note that there is not a predetermined number of saints coming with the Lord. The Calvinist cannot provide biblical support for their doctrine of limited atonement. The bible says "Come...take the water of life freely." (Rev 22:17).

Song 6:8-13 This passage describes the Marriage of the Lamb, followed by the Second Coming of the Lord with His bride. She is fair as the moon, clear as the sun (after the cleansing of the Judgment Seat), and "**terrible as an army with banners.**" The Lord will come with "**the company of two armies**" (vs 13). One army is angelic. The other army is the Church.

Gen 32:1-2 When Jacob saw the angels of God, he said, This is God's host. He named the place Mahanaim, which means TWO hosts.

Jdg 5:19-20 The stars (Angels, Rev 1:10) from heaven fought against Sisera (a type of the Antichrist). Here is a preview of the future battle at Armageddon.

- Barak and Deborah fought against Sisera, the captain of the host of Canaan.
- Barak is a type of Christ.
- Deborah is a type of the Church (the bride).
- Deborah's song in Judges 5 doesn't match the battle that took place in Judges 4 because her song is a prophecy of the future battle

Zech 14:5 Following an earthquake, the Lord shall come, "**and all the saints with thee.**"

Job 25:1-3 Peace will come after dominion and fear. Jesus Christ will come with His numberless armies, and every eye shall see "his light arise." (Rev 1:7).

Joel 3:9-11 The Lord challenges the Gentiles to prepare for war and to say, "I am strong." Then He comes down with His mighty ones (vs 11) and destroys them all.

Hab 3:8 When the Lord comes in wrath, He comes with horses (plural) and chariots (plural) because He is not coming alone.

2 Thes 1:6-10 When the Lord returns to punish them that know not God, He will be “**revealed from heaven with his mighty angels**” (vs 7) and will be “**glorified in his saints, and...admired in all them that believe.**”

- This reveals what the saints are going to do at Armageddon. We are going to watch and admire what the Lord is going to do.

Heb 2:9-10 When Jesus Christ died for every man, he brought “**many sons unto glory.**” “Glory” is not a place. It is what God makes us. We are made partakers of His glory (1 Pet 5:1).

- **Glory:** brightness, luster, splendor, magnificence, divine perfections or excellence. Our glory will be manifested by the absence of sin.

Php 3:20-21 The Lord will fashion our new bodies to be like His glorious body. The fact that it will be free from sin is what makes it glorious. It will no longer be “vile.”

Col 3:4 We will appear with Christ in glory (not a place, but the character and quality of a person).

- Because we will be like Christ, He will be able to trust us to rule over cities, etc.

1 Jn 3:1-3 The bible says we shall “**be like him,**” not look like him. We’ll be pure, holy, and sinless.

Psa 58:10-11 When the Lord comes in vengeance, the righteous will rejoice and renew their confidence in Him. He is the Lord that keeps His word.

Joel 2:10-11 The earth will quake, the sun, moon, and stars will be darkened, and the Lord will come with His armies (plural).

Mal 3:16-18 Here is a description of those that fear the Lord.

- We speak often one to another (vs 16). Fellowship.
 - Our thoughts and deeds will be judged at the Judgment Seat (vs 16).
 - We are rewarded with jewels and spared as sons (vs 17). No Tribulation for us.
 - We’ll return with the Lord and discern between the righteous and the wicked (vs 18). This is the millennial reign and our part in ruling and judging.

Mal 4:1-3 Here is another description of the Lord coming down with His hosts and burning up His enemies.
