# **REVELATION Lesson 199**

## Chapter 21:10-21 — New Jerusalem: A Literal City

#### WHY WE BELIEVE NEW JERUSALEM IS A LITERAL CITY:

#### 1. THE DESCRIPTION DEMANDS IT.

- a. We have a very detailed description of the materials used to make this city: gold, gemstones, pearls, gates, foundations, engravings, with precise measurements.
- b. We must believe what is written in the scriptures to be literal or else we cannot trust anything the bible says.
  - i. The bible will tell you if something is figurative or a symbol of something else. Otherwise, we ought to accept that it is literal.
- c. These materials are literal everywhere else they are found in the bible.
  - i. **Exodus 28:15-21** The gold and the 12 gemstones in the High Priest's breastplate were literal materials.
    - 1. Men collected the gold and jewels and produced the breastplate. Therefore, they don't have any trouble believing that this was a literal object.
    - 2. God is the One creating New Jerusalem. This causes men to doubt because they can't see it, and it's out of their control.
  - ii. **Revelation 1:5-6** God hath made us kings and priests. Therefore, it is fitting that we be clothed with a transparent city containing precious stones such as those that were on the High Priest's golden breastplate, engraved with the names of the tribes.
    - 1. That priestly breastplate typified the future New Jerusalem. (Eccl 3:14-15).

#### 2. ABRAHAM AND THE PATRIARCHS LOOKED FOR A CITY, NOT A "STATE OF MIND."

- a. Abraham never established a city. He sojourned all the days of his life as a stranger.
  - i. No earthly city would ever satisfy the longing of their heart. God had shown them a city that was waiting up in heaven.
  - ii. The city they looked for was a literal city in heavenly places built by God (Heb 11:10).
    1. Jesus said, "I go to PREPARE a place for you." (John 14:2)

#### 3. GOD REQUIRES MEN TO HAVE FAITH IN WHAT HE SAYS IN THE WHOLE BIBLE.

- a. People have trouble believing heavenly things (John 3:12) such as the contents of Revelation 21-22.
- 4. IF YOU DENY THE <u>NEW</u> JERUSALEM, YOU MUST ALSO DENY THE <u>MILLENNIAL</u> JERUSALEM (EZEKIEL 40-48).
  - a. Neither city has ever been seen.
- 5. GOD TELLS YOU IN THE SCRIPTURES IF SOMETHING (SUCH AS A CITY) IS SPIRITUAL AND NOT LITERAL.
  - a. **Revelation 11:8** Jerusalem is <u>spiritually</u> called Sodom and Egypt.
  - b. Babylon, the mighty city is a literal city (**Revelation 18:10**).
  - c. **Revelation 16:19** Jerusalem, Babylon, and other <u>literal cities</u> shall fall as the result of a great earthquake sent by God.

# 6. THE IDEA THAT WE MUST ABANDON ALL MATERIAL THINGS IN ORDER TO BE SPIRITUAL CONTRADICTS GOD'S DEALINGS WITH MANKIND IN THE BIBLE.

- a. God fellowshipped with the men in this order:
  - i. No place of abode. (Garden of Eden)
  - ii. Residing in a pilar of cloud and fire.
  - iii. Residing in a tabernacle.
  - iv. Residing in a temple.
  - v. Residing in the city of Jerusalem, built around the temple.
    - 1. Notice the transition from spiritual to more and more material.
    - 2. God is building a house for his bride (material). Note that this spiritual blessing (Eph 1:3) is a material home in heaven.
    - 3. Abandoning all your material possessions in an attempt to be more spiritual is not biblical.
    - 4. God made all the material things on this earth and said it was good.
      - a. Love not the world (1 Jn 2:15): that's not referring to the created earth, but the system of evil that exists in creation.
- b. The invisible God spoke to Adam and the early patriarchs.
  - i. God was manifest in the flesh (1 Tim 3:16) and dwelt among men (John 1:14).
    - 1. God began invisible but ends up very material (in a physical body).

## 7. IT IS WICKED AND HARMFUL TO DENY A LITERAL HOME IN HEAVEN WITH THE LORD.

a. We are going to be absent from the body and present WITH the Lord (2 Cor 5:8). The Lord is in a literal place.

#### CITY LIFE

Some say "because Cain (the murderer) built the first city, cities are no good. Therefore, New Jerusalem can't possibly be a literal city." These people forget that Satan has been counterfeiting God's plans from the beginning. He got Cain to murder his brother and build a city because he knew God had plans to build a city (New Jerusalem).

Genesis 4:17 — Cain "builded a city."

**Genesis 4:16** — "**Cain went OUT**—**from the presence of the Lord**." The city is not the evil thing. Departing from the Lord is the devil's work.

• In the Holy City, New Jerusalem, no one will be departing from the presence of the Lord.

**Psalm 49:11-13** — Today man continues to build cities after the manner of Cain: cities that honor men instead of honoring God.

• God's Holy City will honor His Son, Jesus Christ forever. That's the PLACE—where we will live!
